

UC Health currently leases 43 spaces in Madison Lot for \$40/month per space, weekdays 7am-5pm. EWHA is in negotiation with Star Parking to professionally manage the lots. Parking rates proposed in the draft contract with Star: Monthly over-night: \$35/month. Monthly all day parking: \$65/month Daytime hourly parking: \$1/hour. Evening parking: flat rate of \$5 Special Events will be evaluated on an individual basis. Applied and received NBD grant for parking machines and related improvements. Until machines are installed, parking fees will be collected in cash after 5pm on weekdays and noon on the weekend by Star Parking. When machines are installed, overnight parking will be only in the Madison lot.	None




