east walnut hills walking routes are as easy as 1, 2, 3.

1. ASK A FRIEND

or a family member, or a colleague to join you, or take a stroll by yourself.

2. PICK A ROUTE

orange	1 mi	~20 mins
green	2 mi	~40 mins
pink	3 mi	~60 mins
yellow	1 mi	~connector

3. WALK OR RUN IT

follow the color coded signs on the way and have fun!



orange -20 mins 1 mile route

See the historic Baker House, serene grotto waterfall in Annwood Park, walking paths in Owl's Nest Park and galleries, shops and eateries in O'Bryonville before returning to De Sales Corner.

green -40 mins 2 mile route

Experience historic homes, serene grotto waterfall in Annwood Park, walking paths in Owl's Nest Park and galleries, shops and eateries in O'Bryonville before returning to De Sales Corner.

pink -60 mins 3 mile route

You will see no fewer than ten historic buildings as you traverse Madison Road to O'Bryonville, down Torrence Parkway, and up William Howard Taft Road and McMillan Avenue before looping back to De Sales Corner along Woodburn Avenue where you will encounter unique boutiques and galleries.

yellow -Eden Park & Mt. Adams Connector 1 mile route

As you leave our business district, you will pass St. Ursula Academy and Convent followed by several historic homes on Upland Avenue followed by a short trek on Victory Parkway to the Eden Park entrance and overlook where you can connect to the Mt. Adams walking paths.
