Officer Locke highlighted Auto thefts as a central theme, with a continued issue with Hyundai in particular. There were 5 burglaries, 4 thefts from automobiles, and 2 personal thefts. With Auto thefts still up, it's especially important to never leave car ignition key fobs in the vehicle or in the owner's garage. Officer Locke encouraged the community to lock or shut their car doors while warming up in the drive way this winter. 4. Treasurer's Report.	Vince Accorinti presented. Reviewing the September 2023 income and balance sheet, sent out prior to the meeting. No extra-ordinary income or expenses were incurred during this time period.	None
5. Membership	Chris Davis presented. Membership mailers were sent out to more than 1,500 addresses, with additional left over for being handed out in the larger apartment buildings. It was brought to the Assembly's attention the importance of filling out and sending back the membership forms, as you must be a member in good standing to vote on issues pertaining to the neighborhood. 7. Trash Walk	President Freeman presented. The first Saturday of the month is the 9AM trash walk. A new coordinator is being sought by the Assembly Board.	None
8. Pocket Park	Jinny Berten Presented. The pocket park fountain has been winterized. The San Marco is being re-done by CMHA. Questions regarding protecting the fountain during construction were discussed.	
12. Sue Fullen Memorial Bench	President Freeman presented. It was brought to the attention of the Assembly that there was still a deficit for the cost of the memorial bench. Sue was deeply involved in beautification efforts, including the flower pots on Woodburn Avenue, organizing volunteers for maintain the traffic islands and pavilion, managing Christmas décor on the light poles, and many other things that made East Walnut Hills beautiful. The Assembly is seeking to memorialize her with a bench in Annwood Park. All donations are appreciated and are tax deductible	

13. Hoffman School Update	Drew Gores presented. The Local Landmark Designation did not win, and thus the school is not protected from the potential demolition. The developer, Kingsley & Co, is pursuing a Planned Development for the Hoffman school. Drew had hard copies of materials about the proposed development. The current zoning is RMX, which allows for up to 3 units. The planned development plans on placing 300 units, 410 bedrooms, but only 170 parking places.	
14. Scarborough Woods Preserve	President Freeman presented. A meeting is upcoming and the dates will be sent out to the Assembly.	
15. Other Business	Werner Lange, a nonresident who appeared on behalf of the "Derail the Sale" campaign, spoke against Issue 22. President Freeman clarified that the Assembly has no position on the issue.






