5. Presentation by Dr. Broyles	Rae Vuic introduced Dr. Dawn Broyles who wants to purchase the Presbytery building at 1323 Myrtle Avenue and open a general dental practice in the building. Rae reminded attendees that Myrtle had been rezoned RMX. Under that residential zoning a dental practice is not permitted; however, the Presbytery was using the building as an office as a nonconforming use. Dr. Broyles came before the EWHA Development Committee and then the Board of EWHA to request a 'use variance' for 1323 Myrtle to allow for her dental practice. Rae explained that a use variance only applies to this specific business and does not change the underlying RMX zoning. Both the Committee and the Board voted to approve the use variance as presented and to have Dr. Broyles present to Assembly members and ask for approval for the use variance. Dr	Unanimous Vote


